the odd thing here is, that I'm able to start VPS on another node using P4 2.4 GHz CPU and SATA devices. I was able to start 5 different OS'es in a VPS too (Gentoo, CentoOS, Debian 3.1, Ubuntu 5.10 and Fedora Core 4). After using the same configuration here nothing happens . It's a

bit weird for me now. Maybe the problem is in the hardware and not software related. I mean, that OpenVZ is not working for me on Athlon/Sempron CPU arch, only on Intel based systems.
