> Modify startup of ipv6 sync threads to use kthread\_run  
> instead of a weird combination of calling kernel\_thread  
> to start a fork\_sync\_thread whose whole purpose in life was  
> to call kernel\_thread again starting the actually sync thread  
> which called daemonize.  
>  
> To use kthread\_run I had to move the name calculation from  
> sync\_thread into start\_sync\_thread resulting in a small  
> amount of code motion.  
>  
> The result is simpler and more maintainable piece of code.
