> Veth stands for Virtual ETHERnet. It is a simple tunnel driver  
> that works at the link layer and looks like a pair of ethernet  
> devices interconnected with each other.

I would suggest choosing a different name.

'veth' is also the name of the virtualized ethernet device  
found on IBM machines, driven by driver/net/ibmveth.[ch]
