> The set of functions process\_session, task\_session, process\_group  
> and task\_pgrp is confusing, as the names can be mixed with each other  
> when looking at the code for a long time.  
>  
> The proposals are to  
> \* equip the functions that return the integer with \_nr suffix to  
> represent that fact,  
> \* and to make all functions work with task (not process) by making  
> the common prefix of the same name.  
>  
> For monotony the routines signal\_session() and set\_signal\_session()  
> are replaced with task\_session\_nr() and set\_task\_session(), especially  
> since they are only used with the explicit task->signal dereference.  
>
