I'm starting to find little inconsistencies all over the place such as:

Which lock actually protects sd->s\_children?

- It isn't sysfs\_mutex. (see sysfs\_lookup)
- It isn't inode->i\_mutex (we only get it if we happen to have the inode in core)

At first glance sysfs\_assoc\_lock looks just as bad.
