> When CONFIG\_NET=no, init\_net is unresolved because net\_namespace.c  
> is not compiled and the include pull init\_net definition.  
>  
> This problem was very similar with the ipc namespace where the kernel  
> can be compiled with SYSV ipc out.  
>  
> This patch fix that defining a macro which simply remove init\_net  
> initialization from nsproxy namespace aggregator.  
>  
> Compiled and booted on qemu-i386 with CONFIG\_NET=no and CONFIG\_NET=yes.  
>
