finist wrote on Thu, 13 September 2007 16:30ok, i have good news for you.

When you add a veth device to the bridge manually it (veth101.0 interface) is already in the UP state.

Yes indeed i did not notice that the veth device was in DOWN state, now it work. Thanks a lot.

Quote:At the same time when the script /etc/vz/veth.bridge.addif runs veth101.0 is still down cause avahi-daemon hasn't brought it UP yet. Thus brctl adds downed interface into the bridge and that's why veth doesn't work.

I don't use avahi at all, so it would be good to know why when the vznet.conf is used veth ends up in DOWN state?

Or more correctly that setup functionality is removed then vznet.conf is used?
