Since I don't see full lspci output, I can only guess. The problem could be that you have two NICs and in newer kernel their order is changed (eth0 becomes eth1 and vice versa). If this is the case, you can work around the problem by putting correct

HWADDR=<MAC address>

into /etc/sysconfig/network-scripts/ifcfg-eth0 and ifcfg-eth1.
