- > I see you are using current->nsproxy->net\_ns for sysctl stuff. Normally
- > you should use ctl->extra2 where the struct net is stored. But in the
- > case of route sysctl, it is not per namespace, so ctl->extra2 is NULL.
- > I will look at that and make it per namespace, so you will be able to
- > build this patch on top of it and remove current->nsproxy->net\_ns.

I think that this is quite boring. It is impossible to get the namespace almost anywhere even when it is safe to use this:(

extra2 is a bad place, as it has a conventional meaning for other kernel. For example it is used for quite a lot of sysctl-s anywhere.
