> server3:~# vzctl exec 180 cat hi.sh

> #!/bin/bash

>

> echo \$HOME

> server3:~# vzctl exec 180 hi.sh

> /

Subprocess for bash starts running inside VE 180, begins executing hi.sh. It's got a different environment, and expands \$HOME into /, then echoes it to stdout.

> server3:~# vzctl exec 180 echo \$HOME

> /root

Current shell expands \$HOME into /root. Subprocess for echo starts running inside VE 180, with the parameter already expanded. (vzctl doesn't even see the "\$HOME".) It is told to echo "/root" to stdout, so it does.

Does that sound about right?
