Since checkpointing does not work then there are nfs mounts inside VE, I've mounted the nfs partition in HN and bind mouted it in VE.

```
root> cat /etc/vz/conf/102.mount
```

```
#!/bin/bash
```

```
mount -n --bind /users/staff /vz/root/102/users/staff
```

```
exit ${?}
```

Still gives the error:

```
root> vzctl chkpnt 102 --suspend
```

```
Setting up checkpoint...
```

```
    suspend...
```

```
Can not suspend VE: Invalid argument
```

```
unsupported fs type nfs
```

Checkpointing failed

The nfs mount is not listed in HN mtab, but is listed in VE102

mtab. And is listed both on HN & VE102 /proc/mounts.

I've tried to remove the nfs mount from VE102 mtab but it did not help.

So it looks like there is no way to checkpoint or migrate a VE which acts like an nfs client. Or should it still work with bind mounts?
