Since checkpointing does not work then there are nfs mounts inside VE, I've mounted the nfs partition in HN and bind mouted it in VE. root> cat /etc/vz/conf/102.mount #!/bin/bash

mount -n --bind /users/staff /vz/root/102/users/staff exit \${?}
Still gives the error:

root> vzctl chkpnt 102 --suspend
Setting up checkpoint...
suspend...
Can not suspend VE: Invalid argument
unsupported fs type nfs
Checkpointing failed

The nfs mount is not listed in HN mtab, but is listed in VE102 mtab. And is listed both on HN & VE102 /proc/mounts. I've tried to remove the nfs mount from VE102 mtab but it did not help.

So it looks like there is no way to checkpoint or migrate a VE which acts like an nfs client. Or should it still work with bind mounts?
