So we can easily >>> say don't do that then. >>> >>> Clone flag consistency checking should only be used to enforce >>> cases where the kernel side cannot support correctly. Currently >>> the kernel has no problems with the current mix and match possibilities >>> short of implementation deficiencies. So I do not see us >>> addressing Ulrich's concerns with clone flags. >> ACK:) Since this all is CAP_SYS_ADMIN-ed we can do with just a warning. > Fine with me. > Let's come back to the document, then. :) Let's.
