> with the Xen developers statements. AFAIK Xen is well on it's way to inclusion

> into the mainstream kernel.

Nor is this about Xen vs what we are doing. These are different non conflicting approaches that operating in completely different ways and solve a different set of problems.

Xen is about multiple kernels.

The alternative is a supped of chroot.
