AFAIK the SYSFS\_DEPRECATED hides the sysfs functionality (files) that is not recommended to use, but doesn't disable the sysfs filesystem as is. On the other hand the NET\_NS doesn't require any deprecated sysfs files, it just can't work at all with the SYSFS turned on.

That's why the things look like this.
