> If CONFIG\_NET\_NS is not set, the only namespace is possible.  
>  
> This patch removes list of pernet\_operations and cleanups code a bit.  
> This list is not needed if there are no namespaces. We should just call  
> ->init method.  
>  
> Additionally, the ->exit will be called on module unloading only. This  
> case is safe - the code is not discarded. For the in/kernel code, ->exit  
> should never be called.

This patch looks sane, and reasonable in the !CONFIG\_NET\_NS case.
