If this is still safe for selinux I'm fine with it. It also gets rid of one of them few remaining s_files users which is always good.

Btw, after this patch we should be able to kill all places that check for a non-zero file->f_op because it should never be non-zero. Of course we'll need an actual audit first to make sure nothing has been slipping through.
