Thank you for the hint.

I don't know WHAT went wrong, because permissions all looked o.k.,
but apparently copying with

```
"find vpsdir | cpio -pdmu newvpsdir"
```

does not work quite right, resulting in the error I described,
whereas

```
"cp -r -d --preserver=all vpsdir newvpsdir"
```

does work correctly, and everything starts up properly.
