# file /boot/vmlinuz-2.6.20-ovz005
```

```
/boot/vmlinuz-2.6.20-ovz005: x86 boot sector
```

```
# file /boot/vmlinuz-2.6.18-openvz_xen
```

```
/boot/vmlinuz-2.6.18-openvz_xen: gzip compressed data, from Unix, max compression
```
