> mangled when you copied it over to ovz? That's the first thing I'd

> check: making sure that /etc/nagios/nrpe.d is in fact a directory, and

> that's readable by the user who runs nrpe (user nagios?).

Believe me, thats the first thing I checked.

I've run nrpd under strace and see nothing out of the ordinary; it finds the correct number of files in the nrpd.d directory. Not much of a whizz with strace tho so don't know where to go from here.
