- > Recently David Miller and Herbert Xu pointed out that struct net becomes
- > overbloated and un-maintainable. There are two solutions:
- > provide a pointer to a network subsystem definition from struct net.
- > This costs an additional dereferrence
- > place sub-system definition into the structure itself. This will speedup
- run-time access at the cost of recompilation time
