The following patchset updates the pid namespace infrastructure so we don't constantly have to worry if we have been called before or after `exit_task_namespaces`, by using the `pid_namespace` obtained from a processes pid, handles the general case of setting `si_pid` in `struct sig_info`, changes where we drop signals sent to `init`, and enhances that changes to also work with the per namespace `init`.

Thus resolving most of the big gotchas with the current pid namespace implementation.
