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so, if I take this example:

Apache VPS at 10.0.0.1 (a.com) and 10.0.0.2 (b.com)

should I create a proxy VPS, let's say at 10.0.0.3,

then forward port 80's traffic to it with:

```
iptables -t nat -A PREROUTING -p TCP -d m.y.i.p --dport 80 -j DNAT --to-destination 10.0.0.3
```

then, set apache (on 10.0.0.3) with:

```
VirtualHost m.y.i.p:80>  
    ServerName a.com  
    RewriteEngine On  
    RewriteRule ^(.*)$ http://10.0.0.1$1 [P]  
    RewriteRule ^(.*)$ http://www.a.com$1 [P]  
</VirtualHost>
```

```
<VirtualHost m.y.i.p:80>  
    ServerName b.com  
    RewriteEngine On  
    RewriteRule ^(.*)$ http://10.0.0.2$1 [P]  
    RewriteRule ^(.*)$ http://www.b.com$1 [P]  
</VirtualHost>
```

Is that correct?
