is it save to mount that? And how to mount that?

Since I first have to use dm-setup to create a device so I did that and I got this:

Im not sure I understand it but if I do I need:

dmsetup create <name>
```

```

cryptsetup [<OPTIONS>] status <name> [<device>]
```

I need to mount it only when the user wants to. So not when the system boots.
