> guests at least for a while.

Out of curiosity, why would you run 64-bit guests? It seems to me that in a memory-constrained environment such as a VE (assuming you're allocating less than 4GB of RAM to it) 64-bit would be wasteful.

Personally I think the 64-bit host/32-bit guest setup is the best of both worlds.

Of course, I'm assuming you're using ovz to slice up a host (i.e. for shared hosting) versus using it in a more specialized application (in which case 64-bit guests might make sense).
