sorry for previous message, it was incorrect because I didn't understand Your original question.

You are right, `setrlimit()` set the limits for current process only (and for its new children) and I don't know the ways to set these limits for some another processes.

OpenVZ uses own accounting/limiting subsystem that is not related to `setrlimit()`. OpenVZ allows to set some group identifier for current process only (like `setrlimit()`), however then any privileged process can set the limits for this process group.
