Hey, all. I have a recurring issue, and finally thought to ask about it.

I use PuTTY to login to my HN. I then use `vzctl enter` to enter a VPS. As long as I am in the VPS, I cannot resize my putty window and have the VPS's terminal follow it. e.g. if I make the window taller while running `top`, `top` will not extend to fill the space below; if I'm using `vi`, `vi` will think that the terminal is the old size and I get weird effects trying to edit anything.

Any thoughts on why this happens, or how I can work around it? I've tried experimenting with `stty` and the `TERM` variable, but so far nothing helps.
