due to the new release of a 'cool' scripting language (RoR) I would like setup the following VE's:

one HW-node, one web-server running Apache, and one server for Ruby on Rails.

My Problem is how to forward the traffic on port 3000-3010 from the webserver to the rails server?  
(The proxying inside the apache is no problem.)

I found iptables snippets for forwarding the traffic from and to the HW-node and the rails server.  
But how is it possible to forward the traffic from the web to the rails server and back again(both  
are VE's)
