Hello.

I'm seeing these error messages appear in my error log:

Feb 10 14:37:04 h01 snmpd[18514]: ioctl 35123 returned -1

I tried to get the cause of this error message:

strace /usr/sbin/snmpd -Le -f -u snmp -I -smux -p /var/run/snmpd.pid 127.0.0.1 > /root/snmpd.log 2>&1

I could find this in the strace.log:

veth3003 is associated with VE 3003, in which runs openvpn (don't think that's relevant though).

Anyone knows what this ioctl is for, and why it fails for veth3003?
