Quote:1. Do I still need to load vznetdev module? It is loaded by default, I tried to change the /etc/init.d/vz and load vzethdev only, later on, vzlist gave me an error "can not open /proc/xxxxxx" What vzctl version do you use?.. I thought this problem was fixed. According to bug report http://bugzilla.openvz.org/show_bug.cgi?id=394, it was fixed in vzctl-3.0.0-14. If you use newer version - please, reopen the bug. To wrap up: you don't need to load vznetdev module if you're not going to use venet.

I guess the second question is answered automatically yet...

Quote:3. I have made a customized script to create a bridge device and setup all the network stuff after a VE start. It is working fine. Is there a similar thing that can clean up the scene (delete the bridge, flush iptables and other stuff) after vzctl stop the VE. Probably <veid>.stop or <veid>.umount files could help you?
