Hi,

To get yum working for your VPSes you can apply several ways:

1. Install yum inside your VPS like on the common Centos-5 system, i.e. enter to your VPS and install appropriate packages.

2. Install yum inside your VPS from HN using vzyum utility.

`vzyum <VPS_ID> install yum`

To apply this way you have to install appropriate template metadata package on HN which is usually named as `vztpls-os_name.arch.rpm`. I couldn't have found appropriate package on the <http://download.openvz.org/> but please look at this page
