This looks like (somehow) that you/somebody has deleted the last address of the eth0 and add it again.

ifconfig is basically useless for an analysis. You should check routes configuration. The best thing to do is to install iproute2 package and use 'ip' utility.

'ip route list table all' will give exact information about all tables and 'ip route get <ip_addr>' will help to understand what happens.

Basically, if you see packet drops, you should check the content of 'netstat -s'. Drops are not gone into void, they increase some counters and the exact counter name will help to understand what happens in the reality.
