Hi,

let's share experience with OpenVZ 2.6.24:

I've taken the kernel-source from git <http://git.openvz.org/?p=linux-2.6.24-openvz;a=summary>
and kernel config from <http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.24/2.6.24-ovz002.2/configs/kernel-2.6.24-i686.config.ovz> and built that kernel on a Debian Stable 4.0 aka etch:

- * CT/VE checkpointing and restore works
- * add/del IPv4 IP works, IPv6 can't be used in CT/VE at the moment
- * some kernel errors/failing occurs, will be described at bugszilla.
