>

> When I trie to remount that directory rw:

> > mount -o remount,rw /pve/0.9/

>

> Everything works as expected. But remounting it ro later fails:

>

> > mount -o remount,ro /pve/0.9/

> mount: /pve/0.9 not mounted already, or bad option

>

> This failure seems to be specific to openvz kernel (2.6.24) from git.
