ok. the full routing setup in my VPS looks like:

```
ip link set dev lo up
ip addr add 127.0.0.1/8 brd 127.255.255.255 dev lo scope host label lo
ip route replace 127.0.0.0/8 dev lo
ip route replace 169.254.0.0/16 dev lo
ip link set dev venet0 up
ip addr add 127.0.0.1/32 brd 0.0.0.0 dev venet0 scope host label venet0
ip route replace 169.254.0.0/16 dev venet0
ifconfig venet0:0 192.168.3.250 netmask 255.255.255.255 broadcast 192.168.3.250
route add default gw 191.255.255.1 venet0:0
ip route add 191.255.255.0/24 dev venet0 scope host
ip route add default via 191.255.255.1
```

where 192.168.3.250 is my VPS IP.

191.255.255.1 is fake address.

can you try doing this in VPS, from scratch, after all routes/addresses flush?
