I read through the extensive and confusing wiki article on using private IP's for Hardware Nodes, but it's not clear what I need to do to accomplish what I want.

Can I just have two venet interfaces per VE? If so, are the routing tables taken care of automatically?

I guess what you want is just

```
vzctl set CTID --ipadd a.b.c.d --ipadd e.f.g.h --save
```

and that's it. Here a.b.c.d is an IP address from the first subnet, and e.f.g.h is an IP address from the second subnet.
