You didn't add enough iptables modules inside VPS.
Just append to /etc/sysconfig/vz or to /etc/sysconfig/vz-scripts/<VPS-ID>.conf file the string:

```
IPTABLES="iptables_filter iptable_mangle ipt_limit ipt_multiport ipt_tos ipt_TOS ipt_REJECT  
ipt_TCPMSS ipt_tcpmss ipt_ttl ipt_LOG ipt_length ip_conntrack ip_conntrack_ftp  
ip_conntrack_irc ipt_conntrack ipt_state ipt_helper iptable_nat ip_nat_ftp ip_nat_irc  
ipt_REDIRECT"
```

And start-stop VPSs.

This will add ALL iptables modules to VPS.

You can play further with IPTABLES parameter and investigate,
wich of modules are sufficient for you...
