> vzctl... Strange...

Hardware node it's a Debian Sarge "out of the box", and OpenVZ has been installed following the steps of this howto:

I don't remember any error at installation time..

> I also replaced you MASQUERADE rules with:

> # iptables -t nat -A POSTROUTING -s 192.168.0.0/24 -d !

> 192.168.0.0/24 -j MASQUERADE

>

> i.e. packets coming to 192.168.0.0/24 should not be masqueraded.
