Hi,

This seems to be a strange "/bin/cp" problem. This is what I did to fix it:

\$ cp /etc/vz/dists/scripts/debian-add_ip.sh /etc/vz/dists/scripts/ubuntu-add_ip.sh \$ vim /etc/vz/dists/scripts/ubuntu-add ip.sh

And replace the cp line: # cp -f \${CFGFILE} \${CFGFILE}.bak

with this:

[-e \${CFGFILE}.bak] && rm \${CFGFILE}.bak cat \${CFGFILE} >\${CFGFILE}.bak

I modified the /etc/vz/dists/ubuntu.conf file too: \$ vim /etc/vz/dists/ubuntu.conf ADD_IP=ubuntu-add_ip.sh

The problem still exists with the set hostname which is being set by a function in the function.sh, but I can live without that for now. Anyway this is just a temporary workaround and I'm going to report this bug in launchpad.

Anybody has an idea what is this bug with the cp command? Searching the "as it was replaced while being copied" there are thousands of hits pointing to some sort of bug in cp with inodes.
