I have a HN with a public IP 70.*.1.* /24 in eth0 and its default gw is 70.*.1.1, and I have some 70.*.2.* /27 IPs on the other subnet with the default gw 70.*.2.1, I assign 70.*.2.X /27 to one VE, I can ping this VE from HN, but can't ping from internet.
