Hi all

I want to add 5GB extra space to an existing VPS, but it doesn't work.

I run `vzctl --set 1001 --diskspace 15G:16G`, but when I run `df -H` from within the VPS, I see the following:

```
df -H
Filesystem      Size  Used Avail Use% Mounted on
simfs           8.9G  5.4G  2.6G  68% /
```

And this is on the hostnode:

```
vzquota show 1001
```
