Hello,

I am in dependency hell with YUM on the CentOS 5 default template:

```
# rpm -Uvh http://mirror.centos.org/centos-5/5/os/x86_64/CentOS/rpm-4.4.2-47.el5.x86_64.rpm
--force
Retrieving http://mirror.centos.org/centos-5/5/os/x86_64/CentOS/rpm-4.4.2-47.el5.x86_64.rpm
error: Failed dependencies:
    rpm = 4.4.2-37.el5 is needed by (installed) rpm-libs-4.4.2-37.el5.x86_64
```

```
# rpm -Uvh
http://mirror.centos.org/centos-5/5/os/x86_64/CentOS/rpm-libs-4.4.2-47.el5.x86_64.rpm --force

http://mirror.centos.org/centos-5/5/os/x86_64/CentOS/rpm-libs-4.4.2-47.el5.x86_64.rpm
error: Failed dependencies:
    rpm = 4.4.2-47.el5 is needed by rpm-libs-4.4.2-47.el5.x86_64
```
