I have build kernel with support ipt\_connlimit module.

I have CentOS5, get linux kernel 2.6.22 from kernel.org, then apply patch-ovz005.1-combined.gz ([http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.22/2.6.22-ovz\\_005.1/patches/](http://download.openvz.org/kernel/branches/2.6.22/2.6.22-ovz_005.1/patches/)) after that apply patch-o-matic-ng-20080426.tar.bz2

Then rebuild kernel and iptables.

Results. Connlimit module work just in HN. But I cant use connlimit in VE. I change some config files.

/etc/sysconfig/iptables-config:

IPTABLES_MODULES="ip_conntrack_netbios_ns ipt_connlimit"

```

/etc/vz/vz.conf:

IPTABLES="ipt_REJECT ipt_tos ipt_limit ipt_multiport iptable_filter iptable_mangle ipt_TCPMSS
ipt_tcpmss ipt_ttl ipt_length ipt_connlimit"
...
```

When I trying to enter in VE I have this message
