Subject: vz migrate fails when vncserver is started inside VE

Hello,

I'm doing some experiments with openVZ live migration. When I want to live migrate my VE, everything works fine until I have a vncserver started inside the VE... even when I'm not logged in to that vncserver with some vncviewer, migration fails.

I'm using kernel 2.6.24-openvz-24-004-1d1-686.

The output from the vz migrate -v --online command is listed below:
