Hello everyone,

The problem :

After following the quick install instructions on the wiki I can't start the vz service.

I type `/sbin/service vz start` and I get the error :

'vz' is not a valid service name

Is this the same thing as running `/etc/rc.d/init.d/vz start` This works fine and I get the message
Starting OpenVZ: [OK]

Does anyone know why I get the error message ?

Does it make any difference between

`/sbin/service vz start`

and

`/etc/rc.d/init.d/vz start`
