> I'm having some trouble with my Gentoo OpenVZ container. I wanted to

> install the new baselayout2 version, so I could ditch

> baselayout-vserver. But now when I start the container, the 'init boot'

> process takes all CPU power but doesn't continue the booting process. Is

> there anybody running the new baselayout inside an OpenVZ container?

> I've tested inside a Virtuozzo container, and that worked perfectly fine.

I had no luck getting baselayout-2 running with Openvz. I did have luck with taking a regular stage 3, un-taring and chrooting into it, unmerging udev and creating static nodes under /dev for null, zero, console, ptmx, pytp0, ... and then re-taring it back into a openvz template. So far it is working beautifully.

I don't understand why Gentoo releases separate openvz and vserver stages when a small script can convert a regular stage 3?
