My HN is fedora core 4.

But when I install a fedora core 4 VPS using the minimal template, locales are not installed in the same manner as the fedora HN, and I don't see any LANG setting in my VPS environment.

On the HN, the fedora installer handles this, and I don't know how to get locales installed and configured in the VPS. I want en\_US, but in /usr/share/locale I only see en\_GB, plus various non english languages.

Looks like the glibc installation is a default setup. Is there any way to control this?

In the template config directory, .rpmmacros contains:

```
%_install_langs C
```

and I changed it to

```
%_install_langs en_US
```

and now /usr/share/locale has en, en\_CA, and en\_GB, but there is still not any en\_US.

Does anyone know how to get en\_US locale installed? I could not find answers by searching the forums here.
