> I add vps via the process listed at quick install guide, i can access the

> vps via the server on which it is hosted , but when accessing from outside

> using the assigned IP i access the server and not the VPS.

> I can see the ip assigned to VPS in /sbin/ifconfig of the server.

Make sure

```
# sysctl net.ipv4.ip_forward
```

prints 1. If it doesn't, set it with

```
# sysctl net.ipv4.ip_forward=1
```

To have it set on every boot you need to tweak a config file depending on the distro you're using. E.g. for RedHat-based distros (RHEL, Fedora, CentOS) this is /etc/sysctl.conf.

IIRC this is mentioned in the installation guide.
