Hi everyone,

There's a question with regard to vldump - current version -, which I need to ask.  
I backup my VEs with vldump which often works fine. The problem is that vldump sometimes failes due to vanishing files which leads to an aborted backup. The weird thing is that in most cases vanishing files do not lead to this failure. By the way the vanishing files are caused by some mails in the queue, so its normal that they vanish.

Here's the error-code:

```
