> Hmm, can't it be merged into the ipc namespace then?

That could be done, but since CONFIG\_SYSVIPC and CONFIG\_POSIX\_MQUEUE are separate options, in order to keep ifdefs out of .c we'd still have separate handlers for initializing the sysv and posixmqueue portions of the ipcns. So keeping two separate namespace structs seems like a clean separation to me in this case.
